General Accessibility Features

Microsoft Accessibility

Information on Accessibility Features in Microsoft 365

Check how accessibility with <u>Accessibility Checker in Word, Excel, and PowerPoint</u> tells you about accessibility issues in your Office file. Fixing these issues will help to ensure that someone with a disability can read and access your content.

Google Extensions

<u>Accessibility – A Powerful Web Assistant Extension.</u> Features to assist the user with text spacing, font etc., Text to Speech, Zoom/Magnify, Article Summary, Mouse pointer and colour, Screen Colour Contrast, Dyslexia Ruler for reading, Screen Tint, and options to reduce or hide images and animations.
